

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 7**  
**OFFERED BY MS. RICHARDSON OF CALIFORNIA**

At the end of title II, add the following, and conform the table of contents, accordingly:

1 **SEC. 2022. EVALUATION AND REPORT.**

2 (a) **EVALUATION.**—The Comptroller General of the  
3 United States shall evaluate the progress and effectiveness  
4 of the Federal Transit Administration in assisting recipi-  
5 ents of assistance under chapter 53 of title 49, United  
6 States Code, to comply with section 5332(b) of such title,  
7 including—

8 (1) by reviewing discrimination complaints, re-  
9 ports, and other relevant information collected or  
10 prepared by the Federal Transit Administration or  
11 recipients of assistance from the Federal Transit  
12 Administration pursuant to any applicable civil  
13 rights statute, regulation, or other requirement; and

14 (2) by reviewing the process that the Federal  
15 Transit Administration uses to resolve discrimina-  
16 tion complaints filed by members of the public.

17 (b) **REPORT.**—Not later than 1 year after the date  
18 of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall  
19 submit to the Committee on Banking, Housing, and

1 Urban Affairs of the Senate and the Committee on Trans-  
2 portation and Infrastructure of the House of Representa-  
3 tives a report concerning the evaluation under subsection  
4 (a) that includes—

5           (1) a description of the ability of the Federal  
6 Transit Administration to address discrimination  
7 and foster equal opportunities in federally funded  
8 public transportation projects, programs, and activi-  
9 ties;

10           (2) recommendations for improvements if the  
11 Comptroller General determines that improvements  
12 are necessary; and

13           (3) information upon which the evaluation  
14 under subsection (a) is based.
